TURN in the ROAD

To turn the car around safely, using forward and reverse gears, so that it faces in the opposite direction





- 1 Stop a normal parking distance from the left kerb, car parallel, wheel straight
- 2 Make 1st full observations. If safe, creep forward. Steer quickly to RIGHT lock





- 3 When kerb appears under driver's door mirror, start to straighten wheel
- 4 Stop car, with wheel straight, when kerb points at driver's inside door handle





- 5 Secure car and select reverse. Look left along the road ...
- 6 ... and look right along the road





- 7 Make 2nd full observations. If safe, creep back. Steer quickly to LEFT lock
- 8 While reversing, look mainly through rear windscreen (over left shoulder)





9 Start straightening when left kerb cuts through middle of rear pass. window
10 Stop when kerb points to your seatbelt outlet (wheel is now straight, ideally)





- 11 Make 3rd full observations. If safe, move off slowly. Steer to right
- 12 Check nothing is squeezing past by the pavement or overtaking, and drive on
